- Baptist Cancer Center was the first in the state to offer MammoSite, a leadingedge treatment for breast cancer

- First ground ambulance service in the state of Mississippi to use 12-lead EKGs to transmit from the field, and one of the first to use AutoPulse automatic CPR on frontline ambulances
- First hospital in the Baptist system to implant an FDA-approved Synergy bioabsorbable polymer drug-eluting stent
- First hospital in the state to be named a mentor organization for preventing ventilator-associated pneumonia (Institute for Healthcare Improvement Mentor Hospital)
- First in the region to offer high-doserate brachytherapy
- One of the first hospitals to perform nonsurgical benign prostatic hyperplasia

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
